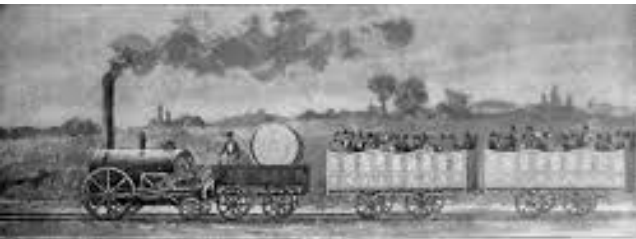


History about locomotive



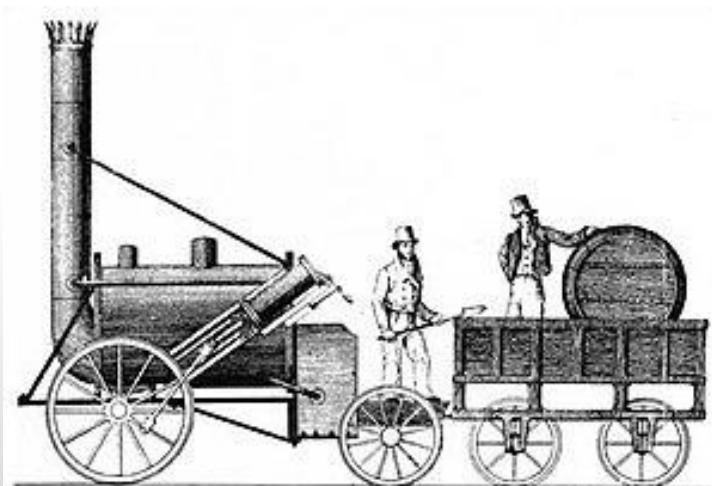
When was the first steam engine created?

- The first place was Virginia City, Montana
- Train did not run again until 1972

- High on steam



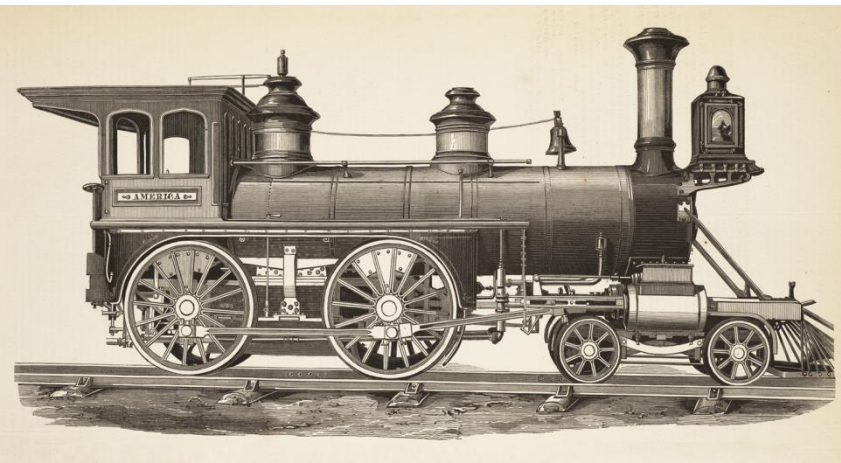
When was the locomotive introduced to the United States?

- September 8, 2005, the Montana Rail link took delivery of locomotive number 4300.

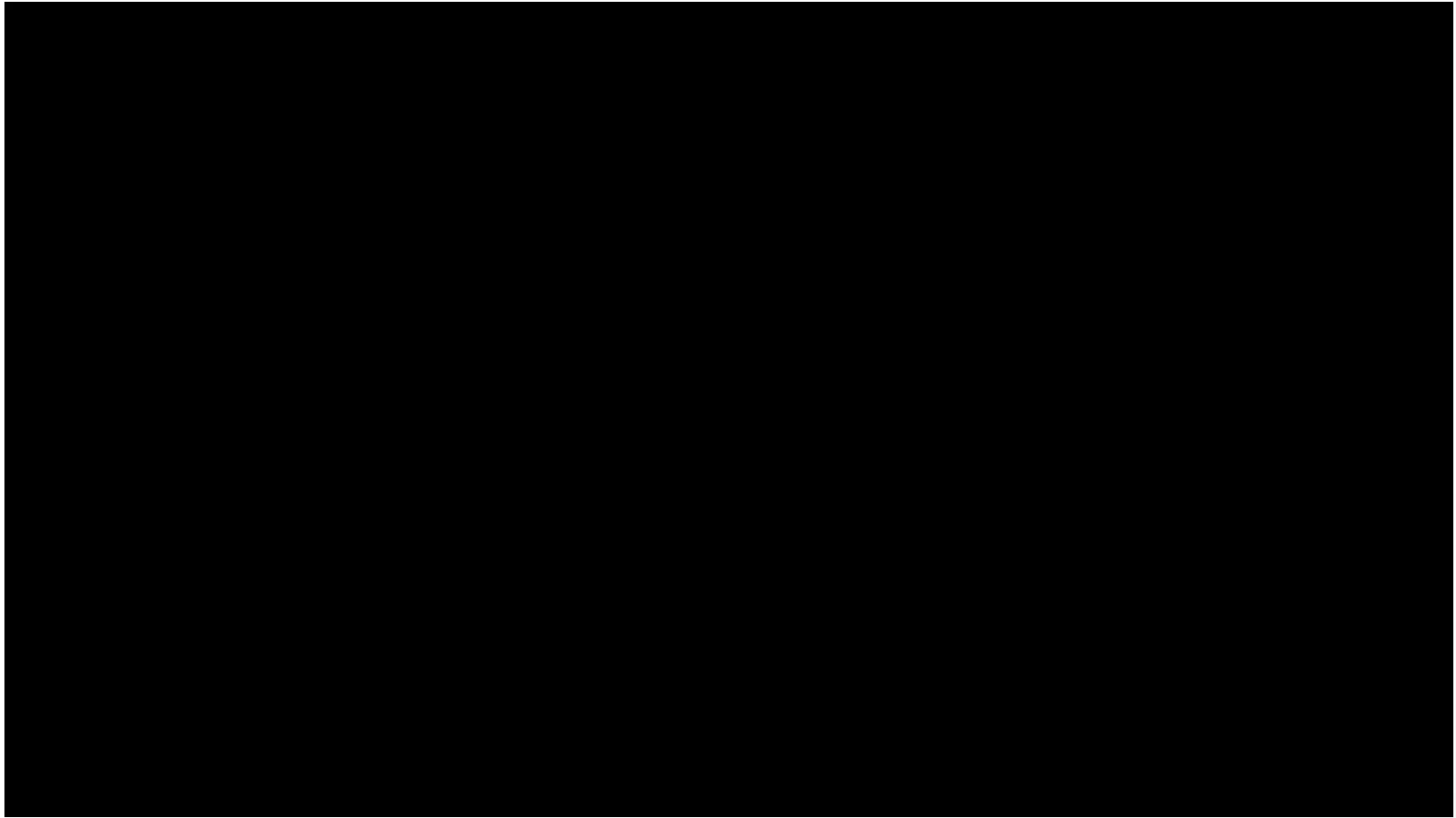


When was the railing brought to the US?
